



Dr. Charles Bennett Mitchell Sr. (1917 - 2016)

Charles Bennett Mitchell Sr., MD, 98, entered eternal life Monday, Feb. 8, 2016. Graveside service: 1 p.m. Friday, Feb. 12 in Greenwood Memorial Park. Visitation: One hour prior to service at Greenwood. Charles was born April 9, 1917 to Bertha Montgomery and Frank Walker Mitchell. He graduated with an MD from Case Western University in 1943. He turned down a surgical residency to honorably serve his country during World War II after entering the U.S. Army Medical Corps in 1944. Upon his return, he completed a residency and fellowship in Anatomical Pathology from Cleveland Clinic in Ohio in 1950. He was appointed to many positions over his 46 years of medical practice, retiring from Harris Methodist Southwest Hospital Fort Worth as Medical Director of Pathology Assoc. of Texas in 1993.
